

ORDINANCE NO 2018-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, OKLAHOMA, MODIFYING AND AMENDING THE CONTENTS OF THE COMMERCE ORDINANCES CHAPTER 8 (BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION), ARTICLE IV SECTION 8-80 (FOOTING REQUIRMENTS); ESTABLISHING SKIRTING REQUIRMENTS FOR MOBILE AND MANUFACTURED HOMES IN COMMERCE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Commerce, Oklahoma;

**Section 1.**

The contents of Chapter 8, Article 4 Section 8-80 of the Commerce Ordinances, shall be modified and amended as follows:

**Any owner who has an approved application shall within 20 days of moving the mobile home or manufactured home on the premises have the same set on a footer no less than 18 inches deep and 24 inches wide, on a four block foundation, tied down every 10 feet, and skirted 4 block high with a 16 inch deep, 12 inch wide concrete footing with axles removed.**
