

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICKASHA, GRADY COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, ADDING A NEW SECTION 2-225 TO CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE VI, FINANCE, DIVISION 2, PURCHASING, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICKASHA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. That Chapter 2, Administration, Article VI, Finance, Division 2, Purchasing, Section 2-225 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Chickasha is hereby added and shall hereinafter read as follows:

Sec. 2-225. - Authorization of city manager to execute documents.

The city manager shall be authorized to execute the following documents on behalf of the city without specific prior approval by the city council:

- (1) A release of lien under the following circumstances:**
 - a. When the lien has been paid in full;**
 - b. When the lien has been shown not to be legally authorized or valid; or**
 - c. When the property upon which the lien is attached has been properly disposed of in a validly executed tax sale;**
- (2) A contract or agreement which, under the terms of this Code, may be completed without specific city council action;**
- (3) Any document that is approved by the city council for execution by the city manager.**

SECTION II. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III. Emergency. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public, health, peace and safety of the City of Chickasha and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval as provided by law.
