Playground & Parks Committee**Sec. 2-54 Created; composition; qualifications, appointment and term of members; filling vacancies; compensation**

- a. The Playground and Parks Committee will consist of seven (7) members who will be residents of the Town.
- b. All seven (7) members shall be appointed by the Mayor upon the Mayor's assuming of the office or as soon as possible thereafter. All terms shall expire at the end of said Mayor's term. Four (4) members are required to be present in order to determine a quorum.
- c. The Mayor shall appoint members in the case of vacancies within a reasonable time of the vacancy.
- d. Members shall serve without compensation. But can be reimbursed for necessary expenses upon approval of the committee.

Sec. 2-55 Purpose of commission; consultation with

The purpose of the Playground and Parks Committee shall be to make careful and comprehensive surveys and studies of current parks and playgrounds, along with a study of the future growth of the town, with the general purpose of advising the Mayor of ways to accomplish a coordinated, adjusted and harmonious development of a system of parks, playgrounds and other recreational areas which will, in accordance with present and future needs, best and most efficiently and economically promote the health, safety, morals, order, convenience and general welfare of the people of the city, including, among other things, the location of parks, playgrounds and as well as other recreational areas conveniently distributed as to population.

Sec. 2-56 Chairman and secretary; rules; meetings; records

- a. The Committee shall elect from its membership a Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.
- b. The Committee shall follow standard meeting rules as the Town Council. See Sec. 2-22 Town Ordinance
- c. Regular meetings shall be determined and announced by the chair.
- d. A copy of the adopted rules and minutes shall be deposited with the City Clerk for inspection and storage at Town Hall.


Sec. 2-57 Duties

The Committee shall have the power to; purchase, hold, sell or convey real or personal property with approval of Town Council, to receive any gift, grant, donation and bequest or devise, shall have the authority to enter into a 501(c)(3), status for the purpose of fund raising and tax exception, to agree upon a budget to be submitted to town council for funds generated by any levy, fee, etc. collected by the Town. These accounts shall be managed and maintained at Town Hall. Authorized signatures on these accounts shall be under the normal rules of other managed accounts. The Committee may also open and manage a stand-alone interest-bearing account for the purpose of managing monies generated by donations and fundraisers. The Chair and Treasurer shall affect their signatures on any and all outgoing expenditures of the stand-alone account.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
