**ORDINANCE NO. 1073**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SYRACUSE, OTOE COUNTY, NEBRASKA TO AMEND ARTICLE IV, SECTION 30-83 GENERAL PARKING STANDARDS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SYRACUSE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF SYRACUSE, NEBRASKA THAT:**

**Section 1.** Chapter 30, Article IV, Section 30-83 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Syracuse, Nebraska be amended as follows:

Sec. 30-83. - General parking standards.

- (a) No person shall park any vehicle, or approach the curb with a vehicle, except when headed in the direction of the traffic. Vehicles, when parked, shall leave at least four feet between the vehicle so parked and any other parked vehicles, except where the governing body designates that vehicles shall be parked at an angle so as to have the front right wheel at the curb or edge of the roadway.
- (b) Where stalls are designated either on the curb or pavement, vehicles shall be parked within such stalls.
- (c) No vehicle shall be parked upon a roadway when there is a shoulder adjacent to the roadway which is available for parking.
- (d) *Except as otherwise provided in this section, any vehicle stopped or parked upon a two-way roadway where parking is permitted shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels parallel to and within 12 inches of the right-hand curb or edge of such roadway.*
- (e) *Except when otherwise provided by the governing body of the municipality, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a one-way roadway shall be so stopped or parked parallel to the curb or edge of such roadway, in the direction of authorized traffic movement, with its right-hand wheels within twelve inches of the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway or its left-hand wheels within twelve inches of the left-hand curb or edge of such roadway.*
- (f) *Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or when in compliance with law or the directions of a law enforcement officer or traffic control device, no person shall:*

1. Stop, stand, or park any vehicle:

- (i) *On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;*
- (ii) *On a sidewalk;*
- (iii) *Within an intersection;*
- (iv) *On a crosswalk;*
- (v) *Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;*
- (vi) *Upon any bridge or other elevated structure over a highway*

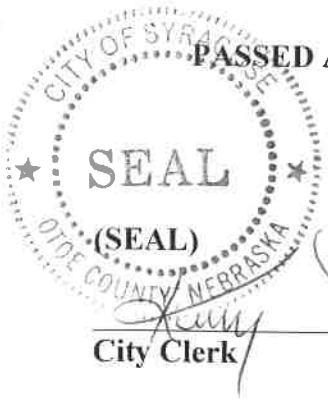
- (vii) *On any railroad track; or*
  - (viii) *At any place where official signs prohibit stopping or parking;*
2. *Stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers:*
- (i) *In front of a public or private driveway so as to obstruct a public or private driveway in any manner which includes stopping or parking any vehicle within four feet of the outer portion of a curb cut on a public or private driveway;*
  - (ii) *On any public or private driveway in such a manner that the vehicle overhangs the street or in such a manner that the vehicle overhangs adjacent property;*
  - (iii) *Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant;*
  - (iii) *Within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;*
  - (iv) *Within thirty feet of any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or other traffic control device located at the side of a roadway;*
  - (v) *Within twenty feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station or rescue squad station; or*
  - (vi) *At any place where official signs prohibit standing; or*
3. *Park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers:*
- (i) *Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing; or*
  - (ii) *At any place where official signs prohibit parking.*
- (g) *No person shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his or her control into any such prohibited area or away from a curb such a distance as shall be unlawful.*

**Section 2.** Any ordinances or sections passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.

Council member Laramie Werner introduced Ordinance No. 1073  
entitled:

and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Council member Deb Dettmer seconded the motion to suspend the rules and upon roll call on the motion, the following Council members voted YEA: Jerry Werner, Orv Gigstad, Deb Dettmer, Laramie Werner. The following voted NAY: none. The motion to suspend the rules was adopted by three-fourths of the City Council, and the statutory rule was declared suspended for consideration of said ordinance.

Said ordinance was then read by title, and thereafter Council member Jerry Werner moved for final passage of the ordinance which motion was seconded by Council member Deb Dettmer. The Mayor then stated the question, "Shall Ordinance No. 1073 be passed and adopted?" Upon roll call vote, the following Council members voted YEA: Orv Gistad, Laramie Werner, Deb Dettmer, Jerry Werner. The following voted NAY: none. The passage and adoption of said ordinance, having been concurred in by a majority of all members of the City Council, the Mayor declared the ordinance adopted, and the Mayor in the presence of the City Council, signed and approved the ordinance, and the Clerk attested the passage and approval of the same and affixed her signature thereto.
