

ORDINANCE NO. 5, 2026

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE 10.24.040 TO CREATE REGULATIONS FOR EQUIPMENT ON ELECTRIC DEVICES AND BICYCLES INTO CHAPTER 10 SECTION 24 OF THE POWELL CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF POWELL, PARK COUNTY, WYOMING:

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Powell, Park County, Wyoming, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 10.24.040- Lights, Reflectors and Equipment shall be adopted to read as follows:

- A. Every electrical assisted bicycle and motor assisted bicycle in use at any time from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise shall be equipped with a lamp on the front emitting a white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred (500) feet to the front, and shall also be equipped with one tail light on the rear emitting a red light visible from a distance of at least five hundred (500) feet from behind.
- B. Every Device shall be equipped with a red reflector of a type approved by the highway department which shall be visible from six hundred (600) feet to the rear when directly in front of lawful lower beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle.
- C. Every device shall be equipped with a brake or brakes that will enable its rider to stop the Device on dry, level, clean pavement.
- D. A Device or its rider may be equipped with lights or reflectors in addition to those required by Subsections (A) through (C) of this Section.
- E. Any minor riding a class III electric- assisted bicycle shall wear a helmet which is properly secured upon their head.
- F. No Device shall be equipped with, nor shall any person use upon such a vehicle, a siren or whistle.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective at the final passage and publication in the Powell Tribune.
