ORDINANCE NO. 035-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 72.020 OF "THE HIGHLAND PARK CODE OF 1968," AS AMENDED, REGARDING OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE SECOND STREET/CENTRAL SOUTH LOT (1750 SECOND STREET)

WHEREAS, Section 72.020 of "The Highland Park Code of 1968," as amended ("**City Code**"), regulates the parking of motor vehicles in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Section 72.020 of the City Code to update and clarify various public parking lot and permit regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it will serve and be in the best interest of the City and its residents to amend the City Code pursuant to this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HIGHLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: RECITALS. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into, and made a part of, this Ordinance as the findings of the City Council.

SECTION TWO: PUBLIC PARKING LOT AND PERMIT REGULATIONS. Section 72.020, titled "Public Parking Lot and Permit Regulations," of Chapter 72, titled "Parking Regulations," of Title VII, titled "Traffic Regulations," of the City Code is hereby amended further to read as follows:

"Sec. 72.020. Public Parking Lot and Permit Regulations.

* * *

- (B) Parking permits listed below shall be available for purchase by the public in the Finance Department of the City of Highland Park. Upon purchase, the decal evidencing said permit shall be clearly displayed in the left rear window of the motor vehicle for which it has been purchased. Parking permit decals shall not be transferable; provided, however, that upon payment at the rate set forth in the Annual Fee Resolution to the City Collector, a decal may be transferred by the owner of the vehicle for which the decal was issued to another vehicle owned by him.

- (1) All-night parking permit. Upon payment at the rate set forth in the Annual Fee Resolution in advance on

or before the first day of each month, the permittee shall receive a parking permit decal which will, when properly displayed, allow parking of the motor vehicle for which the permit has been issued as follows:.

(a) Upon any 12-hour metered space any time during the time period for which meter payment is not required, including the period from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., and any automobile parking space in a municipal parking lot designated for such all-night parking, provided, however, that between November 1 and March 31 of each year:

(i) Parking is permitted in only the following locations:

(a) North Ori Lot (410 Park Avenue)

(b) Second Street South Laurel Lot (1715 Second Street)

(c) Hazel Avenue Commuter Lot (1701 St. Johns Avenue)

(d) Pleasant Avenue Lot (685 Pleasant Avenue)

(e) Ravinia North Commuter Lot (760 St. Johns Avenue)

(f) Roger Williams Northwest Lot (515 Roger Williams Avenue)

(g) Braeside West Lot (51 Blackhawk Road)

(h) 1987 Second Street Lot

(i) Central Avenue East-South Lot (420 Central Avenue)

(j) First Street Elm South Lot (1915 First Street) and

(k) Broadview Avenue Lot (646 Roger Williams Avenue); provided, however, that the all night parking of commercial vehicles, as defined in the Illinois Vehicle Code, 625 ILCS 5/1-111.8, shall be prohibited in the Broadview Avenue Lot location; ~~and~~

(l) Second Street/Central South Lot at 1750 Second Street

SECTION THREE: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
