**ORDINANCE 17-04**

**Ordinance Amending Section 32-81(b) of the Municipal Code with regard to Overnight Parking Permits.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of the Village of Butler, Waukesha County ordains that the following sections of the Municipal Code are hereby repealed, recreated, or amended to read;

**Section One: Sec. 32-81(b) Overnight Parking Permits**

(b) Quarterly permit required; fees. Except for licensed physicians and surgeons in emergency situations, no person shall park or suffer any vehicle of any kind or description to be parked on any public highway, public right-of-way, street, village library parking lot, municipal parking lot, or alley within the village between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., except that in areas designated by the village board, vehicles may be parked during the hours specified if the operator or owner shall first obtain a special privilege permit pursuant to this section, or those vehicles that properly display disabled parking plates or tags. Separate permits shall be issued for each calendar quarter (January through March, April through June; July through September, and October through December).

**Section Two: Severability:** In the event that any provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portions of this Ordinance shall be deemed separate, distinct and independent provisions of the Ordinance and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section Three:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby to such extent repealed.

**Section Four:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and posting pursuant to law.
