

TRAVERSE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 1217

Effective date: September 13, 2024

TITLE: Hickory Hills Advisory Committee

THE CITY OF TRAVERSE CITY ORDAINS:

That Chapter 1067, *Hickory Hills Advisory Committee*, of the Traverse City Code of Ordinances, be enacted to read in its entirety as follows:

1067.01 HICKORY HILLS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- a) Established. Upon recommendation of the City Manager, the Hickory Hills Advisory Committee is established pursuant to Section 30 of the City Charter. This Committee shall be a committee advisory to the City Commission and City Manager.
- b) Composition; terms; expenses; vacancies. The Hickory Hills Advisory Committee shall consist of 11 voting members. At least six of the members shall be City residents. One member shall be the City Manager or his or her designee ex officio with voting authority and one member shall be a City Commissioner with voting authority. One member shall be a member of the City Parks and Recreation Commission nominated by it and approved by the City Commission. Appointments shall be for three-year terms and shall be made by the City Commission, with the exception that the City Manager is a standing member; alternatively, the City Manager may appoint a designee. Members shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in Committee activities.
- c) Organization. The Hickory Hills Advisory Committee shall hold regular meetings at least quarterly. All meetings shall be open to the public. The Committee may develop rules governing their operations. Seven members shall be considered a quorum.
- d) Duties. The Hickory Hills Advisory Committee shall make recommendations to operate, restore, preserve and protect the integrity of Hickory Hills under the direction of the City Manager. The Committee shall make recommendations regarding planning documents related to Hickory Hills.

The effective date of this Ordinance is the 13th day of September, 2024.
