#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF HIGH POINT DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

**WHEREAS**, the City of High Point adopted the "City of High Point Development Ordinance" on May 16, 2016, with an effective date of January 1, 2017, and subsequently amended; and

**WHEREAS**, public hearings were held before the Planning and Zoning Commission on <u>July 27, 2021</u> and before the City Council on <u>August 16, 2021</u> regarding <u>Text Amendment 21-03</u>; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearings was published in the <u>High Point Enterprise</u> on <u>July 18, 2021</u> for the Planning and Zoning Commission public hearing, and on <u>August 4, 2021 and August 11, 2021</u> for the City Council public hearing pursuant to Chapter 160D-601 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

**NOW THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGH POINT, NORTH CAROLINA:

#### **SECTION 1.**

(Regarding low voltage electric fences)

#### PART A.

That Section 5.11.3., Exemptions, to add a clear exemption for below-ground electric fences used for the keeping of pets, is hereby amended as follows:

## 5.11.3 Exemptions

C. Below-ground low voltage electric fences used for the purpose of keeping pets.

#### PART B.

That Section 5.11.5.C., Nonresidential and Mixed Uses, regarding fence height, is hereby amended as follows:

C. **Nonresidential and Mixed Uses** No fence may be erected that exceeds 8 feet in height, unless the fence is 15 feet from a lot line, or it complies with the minimum setback requirements as applied to the principal structure, whichever is

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# greater.; or it is a low-voltage electric fence, as allowed in accordance with Section 5.11.6, Materials.

#### PART C.

That Section 5.11.6.B., Restricted Materials, to add standards for low-voltage electric fences, is hereby amended as follows:

- 2. Fences that carry an electrical current are allowed for the purposes of enclosing livestock (nothing shall prohibit below-ground electrical fences intended for the keeping of pets).
- 3. Low voltage electric fences with a maximum of 12 volts, primary voltage, are allowed in the Light Industrial (LI) and Heavy Industrial (HI) districts for nonresidential uses provided all of the following are met:
  - (a) It shall not exceed 10 feet in height, or 2 feet taller than the permitted fence by which it is enclosed, whichever is greater;
  - (b) It shall be enclosed by a non-electric fence or wall with a minimum height of 6 feet;
  - (c) It shall be separated from any non-electric fence or wall by a minimum of 6 inches, except when enclosed by a gate; and
  - (d) It shall be identified by signs, each not to exceed 4 square feet in area.

#### **SECTION 2.**

Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

#### **SECTION 3.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
