Ordinance No. 6876 - VC

An Ordinance to Amend the Glen Ellyn Municipal Code, to Repeal Chapter 5 of Title 2, Section 2-5-1 et seq., and Chapter 9 of Title 2, Section 2-9-1 et seq., to Dissolve the Civil Defense Organization and Civic Center Commission

Whereas, pursuant to Section 5/11-13-1 of Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the Village of Glen Ellyn had the statutory authority by general ordinance to establish a local Municipal Civil Defense Organization, and did so in 1975, and a Civic Center Commission, which was also established in 1975; and

Whereas, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glen Ellyn deem it to be in the best interest of the Village to periodically review and improve the functionality and status of its various advisory commissions, including the Municipal Civil Defense Organization and the Civic Center Commission, and the exercise of the powers conferred to the Commissions by Ordinance or Resolution; and

Whereas, the Village Board finds that the Civil Defense Organization and Civic Center Commission have been historically inactive for several years as the functions of those Commissions have been assumed by Village staff, and the Commissions therefore serve no current, valid purpose of benefit to the residents of Glen Ellyn; and

Whereas, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend the Glen Ellyn Municipal Code to eliminate and dissolve the Civil Defense Organization and Civic Center Commission.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glen Ellyn, DuPage County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

Section One: The findings of fact and conclusions set forth hereinabove are hereby adopted by the President and Board of Trustees as the findings of fact and conclusions of the corporate authorities of the Village of Glen Ellyn.

Section Two: Chapter 5 of Title 2, Section 2-5-1 et seq., of the Glen Ellyn Municipal Code is hereby repealed and the Civil Defense Organization is dissolved.

Section Three: Chapter 9 of Title 2, Section 2-9-1 et seq., of the Glen Ellyn Municipal Code is hereby repealed and the Civic Center Commission is dissolved.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.
