

ORDINANCE NO. 23-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 11-216 (A) AND (B) OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REMOVING THE WRECKER SERVICE NAME FROM THIS SECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION IN CAPTION FORM.

WHEREAS, the current code of ordinances lists the name of the wrecker service authorized to conduct business on the police rotation list and authorized to conduct private property towing services within the city limits of South Padre Island; and

WHEREAS, the City of South Padre Island has determined that the name of the wrecker service is not required to be listed in the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, when a wrecker service changes ownership, discontinues operations, or changes names, it would eliminate any conflict with Section 11-216.

WHEREAS, the City of South Padre Island deems it in the public interest to pass this ordinance authorizing the removal of business names being listed in section 11-216.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City of South Padre Island and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes and findings of fact.

SECTION 2. Sections 11-216 (A) and 11-216 (B) are hereby amended to delete the names of the existing wrecker services companies authorized to conduct business on the police rotation list and to conduct private property towing within the city limits of South Padre Island, and that the names of future wrecker service companies are not required to be listed in the ordinance.

SECTION 3. That Section 11-216 (A) and Section 11-216 (B) are hereby amended to read as follows:

- (A) Currently the maximum amount of wrecker services authorized to conduct business on the police rotation list is five (5) wrecker services.
- (B) Currently the maximum amount of wrecker services authorized to conduct private towing services within the city limits of South Padre Island is five (5).

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective when published in caption form.

PASSED AND APPROVED on First Reading, this the 18th day of January, 2023.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on Second Reading, this the 1st day of February, 2023.
