

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-11-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANAHUAC, TEXAS,
AMENDING ORDINANCES 51.002 DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN AND 51.003
WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAMS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANAHUAC, TEXAS:


- (A) The City Council hereby approves and adopts the water conservation plan, including the drought contingency plan, ordinances, resolutions, and exhibits, the text of which is on file at the City Hall and open for public inspection, as prepared by IJA Engineers, Inc., previously submitted to the Texas Water Development Board and available for inspection at the Council meetings at which it is adopted. The City shall implement and enforce the program and will submit all necessary reports to the Texas Water Development Board.
- (B) The above referenced water conservation plan and drought contingency plan shall be made available for public inspection in the City Hall on a permanent basis and shall be plainly labeled as being the plan for each adopted by the City.
- (C) The Public Works Director shall be responsible for the implementation of the programs, particularly including drought contingency measures. In the event that measures requiring separate action by the City Council are found necessary, the Public Works Director shall be responsible for requesting a special or emergency Council meeting if necessary, and for presenting the matter to the Council for action.
