

## Ordinance No. 3033-21/22

### Amending Code Related to Holiday Schedule for Solid Waste Collection

**WHEREAS**, staff has recommended amending the solid waste collection schedule to remove the Veteran's Day holiday in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement between the City and the Teamsters, Chauffers and Helpers Local Union No. 627; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it is in the best interest of the City to do so.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEKIN, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 2-1 of the Pekin City Code is hereby amended as follows (additions indicated by underline, deletions by ~~strikethrough~~):

#### **Sec. 3-1-2-1. - City to collect.**

(a) The City shall be the sole provider of residential solid waste collection for the collecting of garbage, yard waste, recyclables, and refuse matter. Solid waste collection shall be under the supervision of the Superintendent of Streets and Solid Waste. For purposes of this Division, "residential" shall refer to all single-family residences, and multi-family residences consisting of four units or less.

(b) All garbage shall be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. the day of collection. Days of collection are established and available from the Street Department office or on the City website. The schedule will change during those weeks in which an observed holiday occurs. Holidays observed by the City are:

(1) New Year's Day.

(2) Memorial Day.

(3) Fourth of July.

(4) Labor Day.

~~(5) Veterans Day.~~

~~(6) Thanksgiving Day.~~

~~(7) Christmas Day.~~


Holidays that occur on a Saturday or Sunday will be observed either Friday or Monday.

(c) Receptacles placed for pick-up shall be placed at or near the alley lot line (if permitted by the City) or curblines where the pick-up occurs. Receptacles placed at the curblines may be so placed for a period not to exceed 24 hours.


**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
