

ORDINANCE TO AMEND

THE TOWN OF ELON CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 7

That the following sections of the Town of Elon Code of Ordinances be amended as follows.

Whereas, the Town Council adopted Ordinance Number 18-760 on July 10, 2018; and

Whereas, such Ordinance adopted a recodified Code of Ordinances for the Town, effective August 14, 2018; and

Whereas, the Town staff has reviewed the recodified Code of Ordinances for purposes of implementation and consistency before submission to the codification service; and

Whereas, the Town staff identified changes and corrections related to content that need to be made to the text repealed and adopted August 14, 2018; and

Whereas, the Town of Elon Code of Ordinances contain sections that require updating to be in compliance with current practice and North Carolina General Statutes; and

Whereas, the Town of Elon Charter section 2.7 and Town of Elon Code of Ordinances Section 1.4 establish uniform procedures for amending the text of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Elon, North Carolina that:


Section 1. Chapter 7 - Buildings and Building Codes, Section 7.2 - Penalty for beginning work without permit of the Town Code is amended by changing the second sentence to read: The Planning Director, Fire Chief, and Fire Marshal may issue stop work orders for noncompliance with the Town Zoning Ordinance or violation of other applicable town ordinances.

Section 2. That the changes and revisions referenced herein are hereby incorporated into the recodified Town of Elon Code of Ordinances.

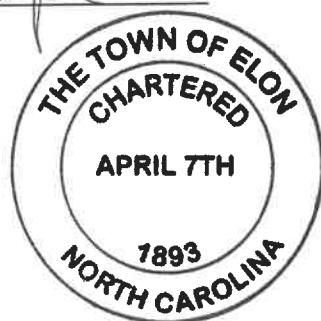
Section 3. That revision of an editorial nature by staff or the authorized codification service relating to capitalization, grammar, numbering of sections and subsections, cross references, and similar edits unrelated to content, implementation or legality are authorized without further action by the Town Council.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
