



ORDINANCE 022-2021

TO APPROVE PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION TO REPEAL SECTION 1129.10(a),
POLITICAL SIGNS, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Section 11.29.10(a) (formerly codified as 1143.10(a)) in 2011 as a result of the City's and public's desire to preserve the appearance of the community which can be compromised by the decay and weathering of an abundance of temporary political signs left outside for an extended period of time, and

WHEREAS, an ordinance that places a time limitation on the display of political signs is contrary to Ohio law and thus unenforceable. See City of Painesville Bldg. Dept. V. Dworkin & Berstein, 733 N.E.2d 1152 (Ohio 2000);

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2021 the Planning Commission reviewed Section 1129.10(a) of the Marysville Codified Ordinances, and has recommended Section 1129.10(a) be repealed and the remainder of Section 1129.10 be relettered and remain intact, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE, OHIO, That:

SECTION I. Pursuant to Sections 1141.35 and 1141.36 of the Marysville Codified Ordinances, City Council has held a public hearing on the aforementioned zoning amendment with the publication of at least seven (7) days' notice of said hearing.

SECTION II. Part Eleven, Planning and Zoning Code, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marysville, is hereby amended, to repeal Section 1129.10(a).

SECTION III. The remainder of Section 1129.10 shall hereby be relettered and remain intact.
