ORDINANCE 051-2022

TO AUTHORIZE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CITY'S SHARE OF CONSTRUCTION COSTS FOR THE AUTOMOTIVE AND MOBILITY INNOVATION CENTER (AMIC) AND MODIFY THE 2022 ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, On October 11, 2021, the City Council approved Resolution 010-2021 which authorized the City Manager to enter into a joint governmental agreement between the Marysville-Union County Port Authority, City of Marysville, and the Union County Board of Commissioners to create and establish the Automotive and Mobility Innovation Center (AMIC); and

WHEREAS, escalating construction costs have resulted in an increased cost estimate to complete construction of the AMIC; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made by the Marysville-Union County Port Authority for the Union County Commissioners and the Council for the City of Marysville to equally divide the construction cost increase; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE, OHIO, That:

SECTION I. That the supplemental appropriation for the City's share of the increased construction costs, \$290,000, is hereby authorized to complete construction of the Automotive and Mobility Innovation Center (AMIC).

SECTION II. That the 2022 Annual Operating Budget of the City of Marysville be amended.
