ORDINANCE 5-17

TO AMEND SECTION 351.03, PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE

WHEREAS, Section 351.03 of the City of Marysville Codified Ordinances prohibits the standing or parking in certain places of the City of Marysville, and

WHEREAS, the City of Marysville desires to better ensure available resident parking on some of its public streets and desires to prohibit the obstructing of public sidewalks, and

WHEREAS, the Public Affairs Committee has reviewed Section 351.03 of the Codified Ordinances and therefore recommends that it be amended as attached in Exhibit A, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE, OHIO, That:

SECTION I. Section 351.03 of the Marysville Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as attached in Exhibit A.

SECTION II. The remainder of Chapter 351 shall remain intact.

351.03 PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Traffic Code, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device, in any of the following places:

- (a) On a sidewalk, curb or street lawn area, except a bicycle; no part of any vehicle, trailer or cargo shall obstruct a sidewalk, regardless of whether the vehicle, trailer or cargo is otherwise parked in a driveway;
 - (b) In front of a public or private driveway;
 - (c) Within an intersection;
 - (d) Within ten feet of a fire hydrant;
 - (e) On a crosswalk;
 - (f) Within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- (g) Within thirty feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon, stop sign or traffic control device;
- (h) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by a traffic control device;
 - (i) Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (j) Within twenty feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and, on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within seventy-five feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs;
- (k) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
 - (l) Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (m) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a street, or within a street tunnel; (ORC 4511.68)
- (n) At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing or parking, or where the curbing or street is painted yellow, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs. This includes posted temporary "no parking zones" established by the City of Marysville, Union County, the Department of Transportation or any other authorized entity. (Ord. 72-14. Passed 11-6-14.)
 - (o) Within one foot of another parked vehicle;
 - (p) On the roadway portion of a freeway, expressway or thruway.
- (q) At any place where signs designate "Resident Permit Parking Only" unless a valid City-issued resident permit parking tag is clearly displayed in the vehicle. (ORC 4511.68)

RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING POLICY & PERMIT PARKING TAG APPLICATION

The purpose of this policy is to provide a uniform approach to the consideration of regulation of residential permit parking zones on City streets and to establish the rules and regulations regarding residential permit parking zones and the use of permit parking tags.

The following will be taken into consideration when reviewing the request for the establishment of a residential permit parking zone:

- A. The requested residential parking is adjacent to a non-residential use that is utilizing on-street parking spaces to meet the required parking needed for the development.
- B. The available off-street parking for the requesting residential property is two (2) spaces or less.
- C. The time of day for the parking demand of the non-residential use coincides with the parking need for the requesting residential property.

Rules and regulations for residential permit parking zones and the use of permit parking tags:

- 1. Permit parking tags shall be obtained at Marysville City Hall, 209 S. Main St., during regular business hours.
- 2. Persons eligible to obtain permit parking tags shall be legal residents adjacent to a residential permit parking zone as established by street signage.
- 3. One (1) tag will be provided per residential unit adjacent to the zone. Each resident is responsible for the numbered tag issued to them.
- 4. Permit parking tags shall be displayed on the inside rearview mirror of the motor vehicle. Any vehicle parked in a residential permit parking zone and not displaying the permit parking tag in the correct location will be ticketed.
- 5. Proof of residency shall be provided at the time of application; proof shall consist of one of the following: motor vehicle registration, operator's license, rent receipt, mortgage payment or other documentation indicating the applicable street address is the applicant's primary residence.
- 6. Permit tags shall remain the property of the City of Marysville.
- 7. When any person ceases to reside in the residential permit parking zone, the issued tag must be returned to the City of Marysville.
- 8. A lost or stolen permit parking tag will be replaced upon re-application and payment of a \$2.00 replacement fee.
- 9. Permit parking tags are intended for use by Marysville Residents only.

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There is no fee for submitting this application. Copies of approved or rejected applications will be returned to the applicant by mail or email within five (5) business days of receipt.
