ORDINANCE NO. 267

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 258 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A UNIFORM PAY PLAN FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS; PROVIDING FOR STEP AND MERIT INCREASES; PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATORY, STANDBY, AND OVERTIME PAY; PROVIDING HOURS OF WORK AND PAY PERIODS; PROVIDING SICK LEAVE, VACATION LEAVE, HOLIDAYS, HOLIDAY PAY, AND UNIFORM ALLOWANCES; PROVIDING FOR ACTING EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS; REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 218, 225, 229, AND 243; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PERTAINING THERETO"; TO INCLUDE POSITION OF FIRE ENGINEER; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PERTAINING THERETO.

The City Council of Boulder City do ordain:

SECTION 1. Section 4, Ordinance No. 258, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. The following classifications are established and placed in the salary ranges as set forth above in Section 3:

The City Council hereby declares that had it known of any invalidity of any such section, subsection, clause, phrase, or provision hereof at the time of passage of this Ordinance, it would have passed the remainder thereof without such invalid portion.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective the 12th day of June, 1967.

SECTION 4. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published on Thursday, the 11th day of May, 1967, in the Boulder City News, a weekly newspaper, published in Boulder City, Nevada.
