

ORDINANCE NO. 1357

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOULDER CITY AMENDING THE PORTION OF THE BOULDER CITY CODE ENTITLED TITLE 4, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 5, LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS, DELETING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A LIST OF THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP AND REPLACING IT WITH THE REQUIREMENT FOR A LIST OF THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE OFFICERS AND BOARD MEMBERS AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

The City Council of Boulder City do ordain:

Section 1. That portions of Title 4, Chapter 2, Section 5, LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS, be amended as per the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. VALIDITY. Each section and each provision or requirement of any section of this ordinance shall be considered separable and the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion.

Section 3. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in summary on Thursday, the 26th day of June 2008, in the *Boulder City News*, a weekly newspaper, published in Boulder City, Nevada.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall become effective, after its approval and publication, on the 16th day of July 2008.

City Code, Title 4, Chapter 2, Section 5

LICENSE CLASSIFICATION

Title 4, Chapter 2, Section 5, subsection J, to be amended as follows:

J. Class F: Class F Non Profit Club License

A nonprofit club liquor licensee must be a duly chartered nonprofit organization and is subject to the following:

1. Only club members, auxiliary members and their bona fide guests are permitted service in such club; provided, however, that the club may service its own functions and functions of others or organizations wherein a minimum of twenty-five persons are attending such function.
2. No police background check shall be required for this type of license.
3. Applicants for this class of liquor license must present written proof of the organization's nonprofit status at the time of submission of the application.
4. To maintain this license, the organization must maintain nonprofit status for the duration of use. Proof of such status must be shown to the administrator or his designee upon request.

There shall be filed with the application for a Class F Nonprofit Club License, a true and complete list containing all the names and addresses of the officers and board members of the club, which list shall be supplemented at the end of every fiscal year with the names of new officers and board members elected to the club and the names of officers and board members dropped.

A representative of the city may, at any time, make an unannounced visit to the club to verify that liquor is not being served to the general public and that the establishment is not being operated as a "Tavern" as defined in Title 4, Chapter 2 of this code. A verification of an individual's current membership shall be provided upon request.
