ORDINANCE NO. 019-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIG SPRING, TEXAS AMENDING THE BIG SPRING ZONING ORDINANCE, ARTICLE 4 ENTITLED "DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS," SECTION 4-6 " AREA REGULATIONS FOR ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS," SUBSECTION (e) TO REVISE WHOM THE APPLICATION PROCESS WILL BE DIRECTED TO; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on February 22, 2023 concerning carports and accessory buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission submitted its final report to the City Council on March 14, 2023;

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission recommends the following amendments to the City of Big Spring Zoning Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIG SPRING, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Big Spring Zoning Ordinance, Article 4 entitled "Development Standards," Section 4-6 entitled "Area Regulations for Accessory Buildings and Structures in Residential Districts," subsection (e) is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4 - DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

SECTION 4-6. Area Regulations for Accessory Buildings and Structures in Residential Districts

(e) Special Carport Exception. Carport construction may be permitted in the front yard portion of a lot outside of the required front yard setback if an application for such construction is made to the Zoning Board of Adjustment Public Works Director. The Board will consider applications Applications will be considered for front yard carports provided the following conditions are met:

SECTION 2. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose, the reminder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Big Spring, and it is accordingly so ordained.

PASSED AND APPROVED on first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council on the $\underline{14^{th}}$ day of \underline{March} , $\underline{2023}$ with all members of the Council voting "aye" for the passage of same.
