

ORDINANCE NO. 1085


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, AMENDING CITY REGULATIONS TO ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER IN CITY PARKS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 12 of Title V of the Official Code of the City of Montrose, Colorado, is amended by the addition of a new Section 6 to read as follows:


5-12-6: Consumption in Parks: Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections 5-12-3(A) and (B) of this Chapter, beer may be possessed and consumed in Riverbottom Park, Rotary Park or Lion's Park between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.; provided that it shall be unlawful to consume or possess beer in any City park at any time in a glass bottle or container or at times and Parks not authorized by this Section.
