## ordinance no. 1253

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, PROVIDING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1985.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, as follows:
