

ORDINANCE NO. 1312

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL TRAFFIC CODE TO PROVIDE REVISED REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE TOWING AND DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED AND OTHER VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1:

Section 10-1-11 of the Official Code of the City of Montrose, Colorado is amended by the addition of a new subsection (E) to read as follows:

10-1-11(E): Sections 22-20 and 22-21 of the Municipal Traffic Code are amended to read as follows:

Section 22-20. Authority to Impound Vehicles.

- (a) The City shall have authority to remove and impound vehicles 1) which are tended, or unattended, and standing upon any portion of a street or highway right-of-way within the City in such a manner as to constitute a violation of Section 10-5 of this Code, 2) which have been disabled as a result of an accident, 3) concerning which there are reasonable grounds to believe the vehicle has been abandoned on either public or private property 4) which is left unattended on public property including any portion of a street or highway right-of-way for a period of longer than 24 hours, if in violation of any parking regulations or other provisions of this Code, 5) under circumstances as allowed and provided pursuant to C.R.S. 42-4-1601, et. seq., 6) for safekeeping incident to an arrest, or 7) as otherwise allowed by law.
- (b) The City Manager may enter into contracts for the towing, impoundment and disposal of vehicles pursuant to this section and C.R.S. 42-4-1601, et. seq.

Section 22-21. Disposal of Abandoned Vehicles. Vehicles removed and impounded as provided in Section 22-20 of this Code shall be disposed of, and towing, storage and other fees collected in accordance with the provisions of C.R.S. 42-4-1601, et. seq.
