

ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING STREETS
AND ALLEYS IN THE CITY OF
MONTROSE, COLORADO

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Montrose,
Colorado:

Section 1. The streets and alleys hereafter in this ordinance described are hereby declared and determined to be of no public benefit or use and it is hereby officially found and declared that the same have never been open to or used by the public although the same appear on the official plats of Willerup's Subdivision of the City of Montrose, Colorado.

Section 2. It is hereby found and declared that the streets and alleys in this ordinance described are adjacent to property, all of which will be owned by the Western Colorado Power Company in the event of the approval of Ordinance No. 281 by the qualified tax paying electors of the City of Montrose at the special election provided for by Ordinance No. 282, and that said streets and alleys will themselves be conveyed to and purchased by the said Western Colorado Power Company in the event of the approval of Ordinance No. 281 at said special election.

Section 3. The streets and alleys herein referred to and hereinafter described are hereby closed and vacated, said streets and alleys being as follows, to-wit:

a. That part of water Street South of the South boundary of the alley through Block 27, Willerup's Subdivision of the Town, now City of Montrose, Colorado.

b. That part of the west continuation of South Fifth Street contiguous to the south side of Block 27, Willerup's Subdivision of the Town, now City of Montrose, Colorado, from the West boundary of the Denver & Rio Grands Railroad right of way to the east boundary of Block 28, Willerup's Subdivision aforesaid.

c. Alley through Block 28, Willerup's Subdivision aforesaid.

d. Alley through Block 26, Willerup's Subdivision aforesaid.

e. West South Fourth Street between Blocks 23 and 26, Willerup's Subdivision, from east boundary of Willerup Avenue to west boundary of the alley lying along the east side of said Blocks 23 and 26.

f. Alley lying along east side of Blocks 23 and 26, Willerup's Subdivision, from South boundary of alley through Block 23, Willerup's Subdivision to north boundary of City pumping plant property.
