

~~ORDINANCE~~ No. 82

An ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled "An ordinance concerning plumbing and plumbers."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE COLORADO;-

That Section Forty (40) be added to an ordinance entitled "An ordinance concerning plumbing and plumbers," passed May 19, 1910, and that Section 39

of said ordinance be amended to read as follows:-

Sec. 39 All public urinals must be supplied with flush pipe flush to be connected with urinal and heel of trap; every urinal shall have an individual sanitary urinal ^{receptacle} bowl; ~~the use of cast iron galvanized sheet iron or cement are expressly prohibited.~~ Each urinal bowl shall be separately ^{and independently} trapped, clean-out on soil pipe to have lead connections flanged to floor to receive hopper; hopper to be flushed with seat attached to valve by heavy chain, waste from valve to be trapped when connected to sewer outside of water closet trap. Trap for water closet and valve to be set in vault below freezing and accessible to repairs.

40. Any plumber or workman who shall violate any of the provisions of any section of this ordinance shall ~~be~~ be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding Twenty Five Dollars and may be ordered by the Plumbing inspector or City Council to tear out any work done in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance and each day of his failure to comply with such order shall constitute a continuing offense for which he may be fined in a sum not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars. The owner or agent of any building or premises upon which any work may be done in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance may be ordered by the plumbing inspector or City Council to tear out such work or alter it to comply with the provisions of this ordinance and for a failure so to do he shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding Twenty-five dollars and twenty-five dollars in addition for each and every ~~twenty~~ day of his failure to comply with such order.
