**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-106 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
MERGING THE MARINA COMMITTEE WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS,** The Public Works Director has oversight of the Street Department, Waste Water Treatment Facility, and the Municipal Marina; and

**WHEREAS,** The Public Works Committee currently governs over the Street Department and Waste Water Treatment Facility; and

**WHEREAS,** The Marina Committee governs over the Municipal Marina; and

**WHEREAS,** The Committees frequently meet consecutively and discuss topics of the same subject matter; and

**WHEREAS,** It is the recommendation of the Public Works Director to disband the Marina Committee and make it a part of the Public Works Committee;

**NOW, THEREFORE** the Common Council of the City of Algoma does ordain that:

- I. Section 2-106(3) and 2-106(4) of the Algoma Code of Ordinances are repealed.
- II. Section 2-106(3) of the Algoma Code of Ordinances is recreated as follows:
  - (3) Public Works Committee, which shall govern over the Street Department, Waste Water Treatment Facility, and Municipal Marina and shall consist of six members, including three alderpersons appointed annually on the third Tuesday of April and three citizen members appointed for three-year terms.
- III. This ordinance amendment shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
