

58 ~~(b) The medical center board is authorized to exclusively control and manage the funds~~
59 ~~of the city medical center and long term care unit, including the audit and approval~~
60 ~~of the payments therefrom, independently of the city council and mayor. The~~
61 ~~medical center board is authorized to appoint a clerk or clerk treasurer who shall be~~
62 ~~deemed vested with all powers of a deputy city clerk or deputy clerk clerk treasurer~~
63 ~~under the statutes, including, without limitation because of enumeration, the power~~
64 ~~to handle billing and collections of monies of the medical center and to issue checks~~
