Ordinance No. 23-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 190

Summary

This Ordinance amends TITLE XIX-Private Property Regulations Chapter 190.- Noise Article 1 Section 190 to add Section 190.26 which regulates the use of consumer fireworks by prohibiting same from being detonated except on (a) December 31 from 10:00 a.m. until January 1, 12:30 a.m.

(b) July 4 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. and (c) July 3 and July 5 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.; It requires an application for a permit on other days from the Police Chief; It sets forth the permitting process; and it prohibits use of fireworks on public property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

Code of Ordinances Chapter 190 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Code of Ordinances Chapter 190.026 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 190.26 Fireworks

(A) Use of Fireworks

(1) Consumer fireworks, as defined by KRS 227.702, shall not be used, ignited, fired, or exploded in the city limits of the City of Maysville, Kentucky, except as follows:

(a) December 31 from 10 a.m. until January 1, at 12:30 a.m.

(b) July 4 from 10 a.m. until 11:30 p.m.

(c) July 3 and July 5 from 10 a.m. to 11 pm

(d) Any person wishing to use, ignite, fire or explode consumer fireworks as authorized by KRS 227 and this section in the city on any other days shall obtain a permit from the City Police Chief or their designee with the issuance of the permit conditioned on the applicant complying with all applicable state and local laws, rules, and regulations. Permits shall be on site of the fireworks display and subject to inspection by the Maysville Police Department and Maysville Fire Department.

(e) The permit application shall be filed no less than 15 days prior to the proposed use of fireworks, and shall be on a form provided by the Police Department. The permit, if granted, shall be valid for a four (4) hour period on the permitted date between the hours of noon and 10 pm.

(f) No fireworks as described in KRS 227.702, 227.704 or 227.706 shall be ignited, exploded, or detonated within the city on any public street, public sidewalk, public alley or other public right-of-way, in any public park or on any other publicly owned property without first obtaining a permit from the city. The City Commission, by resolution, may

adopt regulations for the orderly, safe, and peaceful use of fireworks on any public street, public sidewalk, public alley or other public right-of-way, in any public park or on any other publicly owned property.
