ORDINANCE NO. 8150

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RITTMAN, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTIES AND STATE OF OHIO, PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES, EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Rittman, Counties of Wayne and Medina and State of Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected and appointed thereto concurring:

SECTION ONE.

The Municipal Employees shall have a pay range, established pursuant to the attached Exhibit "A" effective December 30, 2019.

SECTION TWO.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for reason that these salaries and wages need to be established this calendar year for payroll purposes and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage.
