

ORDINANCE NO. 4643

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, NEBRASKA, TO AMEND SECTION 32-305 OF THE OFFICIAL CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, NEBRASKA, ADJUSTING THE ELECTRIC RATE RIDER FOR CUSTOMERS RECEIVING ELECTRICITY FROM THE HASTINGS COMMUNITY SOLAR FARM; PROVIDING WHEN THE RATE RIDER AMENDMENT IS EFFECTIVE; TO REPEAL ANY PREVIOUS ORDINANCE OR PROVISION INCONSISTENT HERewith; TO PROVIDE WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 32-305 of the Official City Code of the City of Hastings, Nebraska, is amended to read as follows:

32-305. RATE RIDER—COMMUNITY SOLAR SERVICE.

- A. The electric rate rider shall be applicable to residential, commercial, general power, and large power customers within the electric service territory limits of the City that sign a Community Solar Service Agreement. The maximum number of kWh that may be purchased via solar shares or installed panels is limited to 80% of a customer's annual electrical usage. New locations will be based off of comparable location sizes and determined by the City staff.

Charges/credits become effective in the first full billing period after the acquisition of solar shares or installed panel in the Community Solar Farm.

Solar Energy Share Charge:	\$0.0301 per kWh for customers that receive energy from solar energy shares
Maintenance Charge:	\$0.0062 per kWh for customers that receive energy from purchased panels
Conventional Power Credit:	\$0.0213 per kWh for all customers receiving energy from the community solar farm (this credit will be adjusted annually to reflect the City's cost of conventional power.)

- B. The fee to purchase an installed panel will be \$375.00, not including applicable sales tax.
- C. The monthly Energy Adjustment Charge (EAC); previously called the Fuel Adjustment Charge (FAC) will not be charged for every solar kilowatt-hour purchased monthly from the Customer.

- D. The City may, in connection with its consideration of a Customer elect, in the Utility Department's discretion, to repurchase the installed panel(s) from the Customer according to following repurchase schedule per panel depending on the time transpiring after the commencement of operation of the solar farm:

Year 24 (Oct. 2042 – Sept. 2043)	\$ 20.00
Year 25 (Oct. 2043 – Sept. 2044)	\$ 10.00
Year 26 and thereafter (after Sept. 2044)	\$ -0-

- E. There will be an enrollment fee of \$50.00 to participate in the Community Solar Service. Said enrollment fee shall be due and payable to the City upon execution of a Community Solar Service Agreement. If Customer takes service under the Community Solar Service Agreement for one (1) year, the City will refund the fee as a credit to the Customer's account. If service is for less than one (1) year, the enrollment fee will not be refunded.

Section 2. That the operative date of this Ordinance shall be October 1, 2020.


Section 3. That any ordinance or provision passed and approved prior to the

passage of this Ordinance, and in conflict with the provisions hereof, is hereby repealed.


