



ORDINANCE NO. O2020-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE CITY'S FEE SCHEDULE, BY REPLACING ARTICLES 6.100, 6.200, AND 6.300 REGARDING POTABLE WATER SERVICE FEES AND SANITARY SEWER SERVICE FEES, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council is vested with the responsibility to adjust and amend the City's Code of Ordinances and utility rates from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the City's fee schedule related to potable water rates and sanitary sewer rates needs to be amended; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Dayton, Liberty County, Texas:

SECTION 1. That Appendix A to the Code of Ordinances establishing the City's Fee Schedule shall be amended by replacing the current sections 6.100, 6.200, and 6.300 with the following 6.100:

FEE SCHEDULE

ARTICLE 6.000 UTILITY RELATED FEES

Sec. 6.100 Potable Water Service Rates and Sanitary Sewer Service Rates

(a) Potable Water Service Rates and Sanitary Sewer Service Rates shall be charged as set forth in the table below.


SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
