## **ORDINANCE NO. 231**

## AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT AND AMEND CITY OF LINCOLN'S REGULATIONS ON DRIVEWAY STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln seeks to require new construction within the City of Lincoln to put into place conforming drop curb driveways;

## THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, BURLEIGH COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA:

To amend and enact the following ordinance in the Code of Ordinances of Lincoln, North Dakota:

8-02-01. Definitions

Add:

City Auditor

An "approach slab" is defined as the area of a driveway between the gutter flow line (or the edge of pavement if no flow line exists) to the key joint adjoining the sidewalk.

8-02-02. Driveway Standards

Replace Section 8-02-02.9 with:

9. Unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer, the sidewalk edge of the approach slab for a residential driveway shall be placed 6 feet from the property line; 7 feet for commercial, industrial or school driveways.

Add to 8-02-02:

- 10. Unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer, the elevation of the approach slab at the sidewalk edge shall be 8 inches higher than the gutter flow line for a street with a 66-foot right of way; 9 inches higher for a street with an 80-foot right of way.
- 11. New construction and reconstruction of a driveway entering into the public right-ofway requires the owner seek a permit from the City. The City Council may set the fee for said permit by resolution.
