

ORDINANCE NO. 4732

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, IDAHO AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1, TITLE 8, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 3, AND TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 4 OF THE NAMPA CITY CODE, REVISING PROVISIONS REGARDING THE BOARD OF APPRAISERS INCLUDING THE NUMBER OF BOARD MEMBERS AND COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; ALLOWING FOR A SUMMARY OF THIS ORDINANCE TO BE PUBLISHED; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, CANYON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO;

SECTION 1. Amendments to Nampa City Code Section 3-1-1. That Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 1 be amended as set forth below:

3-1-1. - Board of appraisers; composition; duties.

There is a board of appraisers, as the same is referenced in sections 8-1-3 and 8-2-4 of this Code, consisting of ~~the following: finance director, public works director, city engineer, and three~~ six citizens residing within city limits at large, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the city council. For the three new citizen members appointed in 2023 one will be appointed to a two year term, one a three year term and one a four year term. Thereafter, all citizens will serve on a rotational basis with staggered four year terms. The board shall recommend all rates, charges or fees made and established under authority of this chapter. The board shall also conduct hearings and hear appeals from services, regulations, and fees charged under this chapter. The board of appraisers' decisions must be presented to council for approval.

SECTION 2. Amendments to Nampa City Code Section 8-1-3. That Title 8, Chapter 1, Section 3 be amended as set forth below:

8-1-3. - Board of appraisers; duties.

There is a board of appraisers, as the same is referenced and comprised in section 3-1-1 of this Code and section 8-2-4 of this title, consisting of ~~the following: finance director, public works director, city engineer, and three~~ six citizens at large, appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the city council. As provided in Section 3-1-1 citizens will serve on a rotational basis with

staggered four year terms. The board shall recommend all rates, charges or fees made and established under authority of this chapter. The board shall also conduct hearings and hear appeals from services, regulations, and fees charged under this chapter. The board of appraisers' decisions must be presented to council for approval.

SECTION 3. Amendments to Nampa City Code Section 8-2-4. That Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 4 be amended as set forth below:

8-2-4. - Board of appraisers; duties.

There is a board of appraisers, as the same is referenced and comprised in section 3-1-1 of this Code and section 8-1-3 of this title, consisting of ~~the following: Finance director, public works director, city engineer, and three~~ six citizens at large, appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the city council. As provided in section 3-1-1 citizens will serve on a rotational basis with staggered four year terms. The board shall recommend all rates, charges or fees made and established under authority of this chapter. The board shall also conduct hearings and hear appeals from services, regulations, and fees charged under this chapter. The board of appraisers' decisions must be presented to council for approval.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law. This ordinance may be published by summary.

SECTION 5: Severability. This ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be ready to carry out the purposes of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

SECTION 6: Savings Clause. The provisions of Nampa Code described in Section 1 above, shall remain in force as they existed prior to these amendments solely to authorize the enforcement actions or proceedings, including without limitation, prosecution and punishment, against those who violate said provisions prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 7: Conflicts. All ordinances, resolutions, and orders and parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed.
