

ORDINANCE NO. 4739

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, IDAHO AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 14, SECTION 1 OF THE NAMPA CITY CODE, REVISING PROVISIONS REGARDING THE TERMS OF APPOINTMENT FOR VENUE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAMPA, CANYON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO;

SECTION 1. Amendments to Nampa City Code Section 2-14-1. That Title 2, Chapter 14, Section 1 be amended as set forth below:

2-14-1. Commission created.

There shall be an advisory commission to be known as the Venue Management Advisory Commission for the purpose of advising the mayor and council in directing and managing the affairs of the Ford Idaho Center and the Nampa Civic Center, and to advise as to the potential benefits or drawbacks of the formation of any future auditorium district to be established or proposed either wholly or partially within the city limits of the City of Nampa. The commission shall consist of a board of eight commissioners, exclusive of the mayor, who shall at all times be an ex officio member of said commission.

All of the commission members are appointed for three-year or five-year rotating terms. All appointments are made by the mayor with confirmation by the council. Each year an appointment shall be made to fill the position of the retiring member. When a vacancy occurs for any reason other than expired term, a member shall be appointed to complete the remainder of that term.

SECTION 2: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law. This ordinance may be published by summary.

SECTION 3: Severability. This ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be ready to carry out the purposes of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

SECTION 4: Conflicts. All ordinances, resolutions, rules, regulations and orders and parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed.
