ORDINANCE NO. 2022-08

18021 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMPDEN, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 403, PART 4, CHAPTER 15 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMPDEN CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF VEHICLES ON TRINDLE ROAD (SR 0641) FROM THE MECHANICSBURG BOROUGH LINE TO SPORTING HILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hampden is a Local Authority under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, as amended [75 Pa.C.S.A. 101, et seq.]) having certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hampden has conducted all necessary engineering and traffic investigations incident to its exercise of authority hereunder; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hampden deems it is the best interest of its residents and users of roads and highways within said Township to prohibit parking (including standing and stopping) of vehicles on both sides of Trindle Road from the Mechanicsburg Borough line or boundary to Sporting Hill Road.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Commissioners in and for Hampden Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 403 of the Township of Hampden Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to include the following additional location where parking shall be prohibited at all times:

STREETSIDEBETWEEN

Trindle Road

Both

From the Mechanicsburg Borough line
to Sporting Hill Road

SECTION 2: Except only as amended, modified and changed by this Ordinance, the Township of Hampden Code of Ordinances as codified and amended shall remain in all other respects in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or of the Township of Hampden Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
