ORDINANCE No. 640

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING EXECUTION OF THE SERVICE SCHEDULE K-1, WEST SIDE BULK POWER SUPPLY AGREEMENT BY THE CITY OF WRAY, COLORADO, WITH THE MUNICIPAL ENERGY AGENCY OF NEBRASKA; TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WRAY, COLORADO:


- Section 1: The city council hereby finds and declares it to be in the public interest and in the interest of the customers of the City’s electric utility that the City adopt and execute the Service Schedule K-1, West Side Bulk Power Supply Agreement with the Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska.
- Section 2: It is hereby ordered and directed that the City of Wray, Colorado, acting through its Mayor and City Clerk, execute Service Schedule K-1, West Side Bulk Power Supply Agreement, a copy of the agreement being attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- Section 3: The City of Wray, Colorado, does hereby adopt and approve each of the objectives, terms and conditions set forth in Service Schedule K-1, West Side Bulk Power Supply Agreement.
- Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Introduced and approved on first reading, and ordered published this 11th day of October, 2022 and set for final reading and passage on November 8, 2022 at public meeting to be held at 7:30 P.M. in the Wray Ambulance Barn in the City of Wray.


