

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3-25 OF THE BARTLESVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO KEEPING OF DOGS AND CATS RESTRICTED.

WHEREAS, the Bartlesville City Council has heretofore adopted Section 3-25 (C, D) of the Bartlesville Municipal Code pertaining to the keeping of dogs and cats restricted and now desires to amend said Section 3-25 (C, D).

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City council of the City of Bartlesville, Oklahoma:

That Section 3-25 (C, D) of the Bartlesville Municipal Code is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Sec. 3-25. – Keeping of dogs and cats restricted.

C. All dogs and cats (except animals excluded in subsection E of this section) are required to be licensed and wear a collar with the license tag attached, or be microchipped with their owners contact information.

C. 3. Microchipping for altered pets require proof of spaying or neutering, or purchase of an intact permit for animals over the age of six (6) months that are not altered. Proof of current rabies vaccination for each animal to be microchipped must also be provided.

D. 1. Pet owners may apply for microchips at the Washington County S.P.C.A. Pet Owners can only apply for and purchase license tags at Bartlesville Police Department. All licenses shall expire one (1) year from purchase date and must be renewed annually. Proof of a current rabies vaccination must be provided when applying for a license.
