**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3277 PERTAINING TO FLOOD
PREVENTION AND CONTROL**

WHEREAS, The City of Bartlesville participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP);
and

WHEREAS, The City of Bartlesville is currently rated as a Class 7 Community in the NFIP program
which results in a 15% discount on certain flood insurance policies within the City; and

WHEREAS, The City's current Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance does not meet the new Class 8
prerequisite for elevation of machinery and equipment; and

WHEREAS, The Bartlesville City Council believes it is in the best interests of the citizens of the
City of Bartlesville to modify the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance to meet the new Class 8
prerequisite for elevation of machinery and equipment in order to maintain the current Class 7
community rating.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BARTLESVILLE, OKLAHOMA as follows:

That ordinance 3277 in Chapter 7, Sec. 7-17(f) of the Bartlesville Municipal Code is hereby
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7-17. General Standards.

(f) All new construction or substantial improvements shall be constructed with electrical, heating,
ventilation, plumbing, and air conditioning equipment and other service facilities that are elevated a
minimum of 1 foot above the base flood elevation.
