AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 332 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) ARTICLE II (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) SECTION 332-5 (ONE-WAY STREETS); AND ARTICLE III (PARKING, STANDING AND STOPPING) SECTION 332-22 (PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES), AND SECTION 332-31 (PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR STREET-CLEANING PURPOSES) FOR MANNING AVENUE; AND ARTICLE II (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) SECTION 332-9 (STOP INTERSECTIONS) FOR MULTI-WAY STOP AT RANDOLPH AVENUE AND HARMON STREET

COUNCIL AS A WHOLE offered and moved adoption of the following ordinance:

1. Chapter 332 (Vehicles and Traffic) Article II (Traffic Regulations) of the Jersey City Code is hereby supplemented as follows:

Section 332-5 One-way Streets

The streets or parts of streets listed below are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Limits
<u>Manning Av</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Communipaw Av to Maple St</u>

Section 332-9 Stop Intersections

The intersections listed below are hereby designated as stop intersections or multi-way stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided therein.

Street 1 (Stop Sign On)	Direction of Travel	Street 2 (At Intersection)
Harmon St	West	Randolph Av - <u>Multi-way</u>
<u>Randolph Av</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Harmon St</u> - <u>Multi-way</u>

2. Chapter 332 (Vehicles and Traffic) Article III (Parking, Standing and Stopping) of the Jersey City Code is hereby supplemented as follows:

Section 332-22 Parking Prohibited at All Times

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets, or parts thereof, listed below.

Section 332-31 Parking Restrictions for Street-Cleaning Purposes

No person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or sides of streets either in whole or in part, during the hours of the days listed below.

The purpose of this ordinance is to formalize Manning Avenue as a one-way road and to establish street cleaning. This ordinance also designates the intersection of Randolph Avenue and Harmon Street multi-way stop control to help improve the traffic safety and operational characteristics of the intersection based on a detailed review of the traffic conditions and guidance outlined within the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices published by the Federal Highway Administration.
