

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-14-0007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SUBSECTIONS 116 AND
117 TO SECTION 10.14.020.A RELATING TO ONE-WAY
STREETS AND ALLEYS

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.14.020.A of the Long Beach Municipal Code is
amended by adding Subsections 116 and 117 to read as follows:

116. (Westbound) 55th Street between Linden Avenue and Long
Beach Boulevard.

117. (Eastbound) Louise Street between Long Beach Boulevard
and Linden Avenue.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance
by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City
of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by
the Mayor.
