





RESOLUTION NO. R 11-08-01-05

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR PARTICIPATING IN CLEAN AIR COUNTS, A PUBLIC/PRIVATE INITIATIVE TO VOLUNTARILY IMPROVE AIR QUALITY IN THE CHICAGO METROPOLITAN REGION

WHEREAS, The air quality of Northeastern Illinois affects the health and well-being of all the residents of the metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency standards, our region is currently a non-attainment zone for ozone, and it appears likely that the region will be declared in non-attainment for fine particulates; and

WHEREAS, Local and regional partnerships that unite government, businesses, and residents, in a voluntary effort to reduce harmful emissions of nitrogen oxides and volatile organic compounds, can effectively improve regional air quality; and

WHEREAS, Clean Air Counts (CAC) is a collaborative effort to achieve voluntary reductions in ozone-causing emissions in the six county Chicago metropolitan region, and

WHEREAS, The Village of North Aurora consistently engages in cost effective, environmentally friendly programs, and will work with CAC and other municipalities to reduce regional air pollution; and

WHEREAS, The Village's work with CAC and other municipalities will help prevent the need for more stringent environmental protection requirements related to air quality and ozone levels.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village of North Aurora commits to participate in the Clean Air Counts program and adopt financially feasible strategies required to improve air quality in our community and region.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.


