COUNCIL BILL NO. 19-08 ORDINANCE NO. 19-08

1 AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 15.06 OF THE BUTTE-SILVER BOW 2 MUNICIPAL CODE (BSB-MC) AND REPLACING IT BY ESTABLISHING A NEW 3 CHAPTER OF THE BUTTE-SILVER BOW MUNICIPAL CODE (BSB-MC) TO BE 4 NUMBERED 8.14 AND TO BE ENTITLED "DANGEROUS BUILDINGS", ESTABLISHING 5 PROCEDURES AND PROVISIONS FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR AN 6 EFFECTIVE DATE HEREIN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BUTTE-SILVER BOW, STATE OF MONTANA:

- SECTION 1: <u>New Chapter:</u> There is hereby created a new Chapter of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be named "DANGEROUS BUILDINGS" and numbered Chapter 8.14.
- 9 SECTION 2: <u>New Section:</u> There is hereby created a new section
 10 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to
 11 be numbered 8.14.010 which shall read as follows:
 12 <u>8.14.010 Purpose.</u> The purpose of this chapter is
 13 to protect the public health, safety and welfare by
 14 establishing a method to be cumulative with and in
 15 addition to any other remedy provided by the

1International Existing Building Code, or otherwise2available by law, whereby buildings or structures,3which from any cause, endanger the life, limb,4health, property, safety or welfare of the general5public or their occupants, may be required to be6repaired, vacated or demolished.

- 7 SECTION 3: <u>New Section:</u> There is hereby created a new section 8 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to 9 be numbered 8.14.020 which shall read as follows: 10 8.14.020 SCOPE. The provisions of this chapter shall 11 apply to all dangerous buildings, as hereindefined, 12 which are now in existence or which may hereafter 13 become dangerous within the City-County of Butte-14 Silver Bow, Montana.
- 15SECTION 4:New Section:There is hereby created a new section16of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to17be numbered 8.14.030 which shall read as follows:188.14.030 Alterations, Additions and Repairs. All19buildings or structures which are required to be20repaired under the provisions of this chapter shall21be required to obtain the appropriate permits as

1required by the City-County of Butte-Silver Bow, MT.2SECTION 5:New Section:3of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to4be numbered 8.14.040 which shall read as follows:

5 <u>8.14.040 Definitions:</u>

6 The following definitions shall apply unless the 7 context clearly indicates or requires a different 8 meaning.

9 "CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" means an enforcement в. 10 officer of the City-County Community Enrichment 11 Department, the City-County Fire Department, the 12 City-County Planning/Building Code Department or any 13 other City-County Department, officer or employee 14 appointed by the Chief Executive with the 15 appropriate qualifications whose job duties include 16 enforcing the regulations of this chapter by 17 addressing buildings or structures, which from any 18 cause, endanger the life, limb, health, property, 19 safety or welfare of the general public or their 20 occupants.

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1C. "COUNCIL of COMMISSIONERS" means the members2elected to serve as the governing body of the City-3County of Butte-Silver Bow.

4 D. "DANGEROUS BUILDING" means for the purpose of 5 this chapter, any building or structure which has 6 any or all of the conditions or defects hereinafter 7 described, as determined by a Code Enforcement 8 Officer and/or by an outside registered design 9 professional, provided that such conditions or 10 defects exist to the extent that the life, health, 11 property or safety of the public or its occupants 12 are endangered:

- 131. Whenever the exterior walls or other14vertical structural members list, lean or15buckle to such an extent that a plumb line16passing through the center of gravity does17not fall inside the middle one third of the18base.
- 192. Whenever the stress in any materials,20member or portion thereof, due to all dead21and live loads, is more than one and one

1	half times the working stress or stresses
2	allowed in the International Existing
3	Building Code for buildings of similar
4	structure, purpose or location.

- 5 3. Whenever any portion thereof has been 6 damaged by fire, earthquake, wind, flood or 7 by any other cause, to such an extent that 8 structural strength or stability the 9 thereof is materially less than it was 10 before such catastrophe and is less than 11 the minimum requirements of the 12 International Existing Building Code for 13 buildings of similar structure, purpose or 14 location.
- 15 4. Whenever portion any or member or 16 appurtenance thereof is likely to fail, or 17 become detached or dislodged, or to 18 collapse and thereby injure persons or 19 damage property.
- 205. Whenever any portion of a building, or any21member, appurtenance or ornamentation on

1 the exterior thereof is not of sufficient 2 strength or stability, or is not so 3 anchored, attached or fastened in place so 4 as to be capable of resisting a wind 5 pressure of one half of that specified in 6 the International Existing Building Code 7 forbuildings of similar structure, purpose 8 or locations without exceeding the working 9 stresses permitted in the International 10 Existing Building Code for such buildings.

116. Whenever any portion thereof has wracked,12warped, buckled or settled to such an13extent that walls or other structural14portions have materially less resistance to15winds or earthquakes than is required in16the case of similar new construction.

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7. Whenever the building or structure, or any
18 portion thereof, because of (i)
19 dilapidation, deterioration or decay; (ii)
20 faulty construction; (iii) the removal,
21 movement or instability of any portion of

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1 movement or instability of any portion of 2 the ground necessary for the purpose of 3 supporting such building, (iv) the 4 deterioration, decay or inadequacy of its 5 foundation; or (v) any other cause, is 6 likely to partially or completely collapse.

- 7 8. Whenever, for any reason, the building or
 8 structure, or any portion thereof, is
 9 manifestly unsafe for the purpose for which
 10 it is being used.
- 11 9. Whenever the building or structure, 12 exclusive of foundation, shows 33 percent 13 or more damage or deterioration of its 14 supporting member or members, or 50 percent 15 damage or deterioration of its non-16 supporting members, enclosing or outside 17 walls or coverings.
- 18 10. Whenever the building or structure has been
 19 so damaged by fire, wind, earthquake or
 20 flood, or has become so dilapidated or
 21 deteriorated as to become (i) an attractive

1	nuisance to children; (ii) a harbor for
2	vagrants, criminals or immoral persons; or
3	as to(iii) enable persons to resort thereto
4	for the purpose of committing unlawful or
5	immoral acts.

- 6 11. Whenever any building orstructure has been 7 constructed, exists or is maintained in 8 violation of any specific requirement or 9 prohibition applicable to such building or 10 structure provided by the building 11 regulations of the City-County, as 12 specified in the International Existing 13 Building Code, or any law or ordinance of 14 the State of Montana or the City-County 15 relating to the condition, location or 16 structure of buildings.
- 17 12. Whenever any door, aisle, passageway,
 18 stairway or other means of exit is not so
 19 arranged as to provide safe and adequate
 20 means of exit in case of fire or panic.
 21 13. Whenever the walking surface of any aisle,

1passageway, stairway or other means of exit2is so warped, worn, loose, torn or3otherwise unsafe as to not provide safe and4adequate means of exit in case of fire or5panic.

- 6 14. Whenever any building or structure which, 7 whether or not erected in accordance with 8 all applicable laws and ordinances, has in 9 any non-supporting part, member or portion 10 less than 50 percent, or in any supporting 11 part, member or portion less than 66 12 percent of the (i) strength, (ii) fire-13 resisting qualities or characteristics, or 14 (iii) weather-resisting qualities or 15 characteristics required by law in the case 16 of a newly constructed building of like 17 area, height and occupancy in the same 18 location.
- 1915. Whenever a building or structure, is used20or intended to be used for dwelling21purposes, and has an inadequate sewer or

1	water system as determined by a registered
2	sanitarian with the City-County's health
3	department.
4	16. Whenever any building or structure, is in
5	such a condition as to constitute a
6	"condition of public health importance" as
7	defined in Section 50-1-101(2) MCA.
8	17. Whenever any building or structure, because
9	of obsolescence, dilapidated condition,
10	deterioration, damage, inadequate exits,
11	lack of sufficient fire-resistive
12	construction, faulty electric wiring, gas
13	connections or heating apparatus, or other
14	cause, is determined by the City-County's
15	fire marshal to be a fire
16	hazard.18.Whenever any building or
17	structure is in such a condition as to
18	constitute a public nuisance as defined in
19	Montana law.
20	18. Whenever any portion of a building or
21	structure remains on a site after the

1 demolition or destruction of the building 2 or structure or whenever any building or 3 structure is abandoned for a period in 4 excess of six months so as to constitute 5 such building or portion thereof an 6 attractive nuisance or hazard to the 7 public.

8 Ε. "OWNER" means those shown to be the owner or owners on the records of the offices of the City-9 10 County of Butte-Silver Bow's Clerk and Recorder 11 and/or Assessor; and/or other person, firm or 12 corporation in control of the freehold of the 13 premises or lessor stated herein. Any person with 14 a shared interest in the property may have a joint 15 and several obligation for compliance with the 16 provisions of this chapter.

F. "POSTED" means a building that has been posted
with a Notice of Dangerous Building and Order to
Repair or Demolish by a Code Enforcement officer
that meets the criteria of a Dangerous Building
G. "REGISTERED DESIGN PROFESSIONAL" means an

individual who is registered or licensed to practice
 their respective design profession as defined by the
 statutory requirements of the professional
 registration laws of the State of Montana.

5 SECTION 6: <u>New Section:</u> There is hereby created a new section б of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be numbered 8.14.050 which shall read as follows: 7 8 8.14.050 COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDINGS: When the Code 9 Enforcement Officer, or when needed a registered design professional, has inspected or caused to be 10 11 inspected any building and found and determined that 12 such building is a Dangerous Building, he or she 13 shall commence proceedings to cause the repair, 14 vacation or demolition of the building.

15A.NoticeandDirectivesofCodeEnforcement16Officer.The CodeEnforcementOfficer shall issue17a notice directed to the Owner of the building. The18notice shall contain the following information and19directive(s):

201. The street address and a legal description21sufficient for identification of the

premises upon which the building is
 located.

- 3 2. A statement that the Code Enforcement
 4 Officer has found the building to be a
 5 Dangerous Building with a brief and concise
 6 description of the conditions found to
 7 render the building a Dangerous Building
 8 under this chapter.
- 9 3. A statement of the action required to be
 10 taken as determined by the Code Enforcement
 11 officer as follows:
- 12 a. If the Code Enforcement Officer has 13 determined that the building or 14 structure must be repaired, the notice 15 shall require that all required permits 16 be secured and the work physically 17 commenced within such time (not to 18 exceed 60 days) and completed within such time as the Code Enforcement 19 20 Officer determines is reasonable under 21 the circumstances.

- 1 b. If the Code Enforcement Officer has 2 determined that the building or 3 structure must be vacated, he or she 4 shall direct that the building or 5 structure be vacated within a time 6 certain from the date of the notice as 7 determined by the Code Enforcement 8 Officer to be reasonable. 9 If the Building, Official and/or the c. 10 Health Department and/or the Fire 11 Department, in conformity with Section 12 2.64.150 of Chapter 2.64 of the Butte-13 Silver Bow Municipal Code entitled 14 Historic Preservation Program has determined 15 building that the or 16 must be demolished, structure the 17 notice shall require that the building 18 be vacated within such time as the
- 19Building Offical, and/or the Health20Department and/or the Fire Department21determines is reasonable (not to exceed

1 60 days from the date of the notice); 2 that all required permits be secured 3 within 60 days from the date of the 4 notice; and that the demolition be 5 completed within such time as the Building Official and/or the Health 6 7 Department and/or the Fire Department 8 shall determine is reasonable.

- 9 4. Statements advising that if any required repair or demolition work (without vacation 10 11 being required) is not commenced within the 12 time specified, the Code Enforcement 13 Officer (i) will order the building vacated 14 and posted to prevent further occupancy 15 until the work is completed, and (ii) may 16 proceed to cause the work to be done and 17 charge the costs against the property or 18 its owner.
- 195. Statements advising (i) that any Owner20person having any record title or legal21interest in the building may appeal from

1 the notice and directive of the Code 2 Enforcement Officer, to the Building Board 3 of Appeals provided the appeal is made in 4 writing and filed within thirty (30) days from the date of the notice and directive; 5 and (ii) that failure to appeal will 6 7 constitute a waiver of all right to a 8 hearing and determination of the matter. 9 Service of Notice and Directive: The notice and в. 10 directive, and any amended or supplemental notice 11 and directive, shall be served upon the record owner 12 and posted on the property; and one copy shall be 13 served on each of the following if known to the Code 14 Enforcement Officer or disclosed from official 15 public records: the holder of any mortgage or deed 16 of trust; the owner or holder of any lease of record; 17 and the holder of any other estate or legal interest 18 of record in or to the building or the land on which it is located. The failure of the Code Enforcement 19 20 Officer to serve any person required herein to be 21 served shall invalidate any proceedings not

hereunder as to any other person duly served or relieve any such person form any duty or obligation imposed by the provisions of this section.

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4 C. Method of Service. Service of the notice and 5 directive shall be made upon all persons entitled 6 thereto either personally or by mailing a copy of 7 such notice and directive by certified mail, postage 8 prepaid, return receipt requested, to each such 9 person at their address as it appears on the last 10 tax statement of the City-County or as known to the 11 Code Enforcement Officer. If no address or any such 12 person so appears or is known to the Code Enforcement 13 Officer, then a copy of the notice and directive shall be so mailed, addressed to such person, at the 14 15 address of the building involved in the proceedings. 16 The failure of any such person to receive such notice 17 shall not affect the validity of any proceedings 18 taken under this section. Service by certified mail 19 in the manner provided herein shall be effective on 20 the date of mailing.

21 D. <u>Proof</u> <u>of</u> <u>Service</u>. Service of the notice and

1 directive shall be certified to at the time of 2 service by a written declaration executed by the 3 persons effecting service, declaring the time, date 4 and manner in which service was made. The 5 declaration, together with any receipt card returned 6 in acknowledgment of the receipt by certified mail 7 shall be affixed to the copy of the notice and order 8 and retained by the Code Enforcement Officer that 9 initiated the proceedings.

10 SECTION 7: New Section: There is hereby created a new section 11 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to 12 be numbered 8.14.060 which shall read as follows: 13 8.14.060 REPAIR, VACATION AND DEMOLITION STANDARDS: 14 The following standards shall be followed by the 15 Code Enforcement Officer in ordering the repair, vacation or demolition of any dangerous building or 16 17 structure:

18A. Any building declared a dangerous building by19a Code Enforcement Officer under this code shall20comply with the following:

21 1. The building shall be repaired in

1 accordance with an abatement plan and time 2 table established by the Code Enforcement 3 officer and in compliance with all City-4 County local laws including compliance 5 with Chapter 2.64 of the Butte-Silver Bow 6 Municipal Code entitled Historic 7 Preservation Program and permitting 8 requirements and/or

- 9 2. The building shall be demolished in a 10 manner compliant with all City-County 11 local laws, including compliance with 12 Chapter 2.64 of the Butte-Silver Bow 13 Municipal entitled Code Historic 14 Preservation Program, and in compliance 15 with all permitting requirements and/or
- 163.If the building does not constitute an17immediate danger to the life, limb or18property or safety of the public, it may19be vacated, secured and maintained against20entry.

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B. If the building or structure is in such

1 condition as to make it immediately dangerous to the 2 life, limb, property or safety of the public or its 3 occupants, it shall be ordered to be vacated. 4 Every notice to vacate shall be a. 5 by the Code Enforcement signed Officer and posted at or upon each 6 7 building exit of the in 8 substantially the following form: 9 DO NOT ENTER 10 UNSAFE TO OCCUPY 11 12 It is a misdemeanor to occupy this 13 building or to remove or deface this 14 notice. 15 b. Whenever such notice is posted, the 16 Code Enforcement Officer shall 17 include with the notice an 18 explanation reciting the emergency 19 and specifying the conditions which 20 necessitate the posting. No person 21 shall remain in or enter any building 22 which has been so posted, except that

1 entry may be made to repair, demolish 2 or remove such building under 3 permit. No person shall remove or 4 deface any such notice after it is 5 posted until the requested repairs, 6 demolition or removal have been 7 certificate completed and а of 8 occupancy issued pursuant to the 9 provision of the International 10 Existing Building Code.

11 SECTION 8: New Section: There is hereby created a new section 12 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be numbered 8.14.070 which shall read as follows: 13 14 8.14.070 Appeal of Notice and Directive of Code 15 Enforcement Officer. Any person entitled to service 16 under Section 8.14.050 of this chapter may appeal 17 from the notice and directive of the Code Enforcement 18 Officer or any action of the Code Enforcement Officer 19 under this chapter to the Building Board of Appeals. 20 The appeal shall be filed within Έ-€i thirty (±30)from 21 the date of the service of such notice and directive

1 or action of the Code Enforcement Officer; provided 2 however, that if the building or structure is in 3 such condition as to make it immediately dangerous 4 to the life, limb, property or safety of the public or adjacent property and is ordered vacated and 5 6 posted in accordance with Section 8.14.060 of this 7 chapter, such appeal shall be filed within five (5) 8 days from the date of the service of the notice and 9 directive of the Code Enforcement Officer.

10 SECTION 9: <u>New Section:</u> There is hereby created a new section 11 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to 12 be numbered 8.14.080 which shall read as follows: 13 8.14.080 Failure to Comply with Notice and Directive 14 of Code Enforcement Officer. If no appeal is made, 15 the Notice and Directive of the Code Enforcement 16 Officer shall become final and any person who fails, 17 neglects or refuses to comply with such Notice and 18 Directive is guilty of a misdemeanor. In addition, 19 the Code Enforcement Officer may initiate any 20 appropriate action to abate such building as a public 21 nuisance.

1 SECTION 10: New Section: There is hereby created a new section 2 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to 3 be numbered 8.14.090 which shall read as follows: 8.14.090. EXTENSION OF TIME TO PERFORM WORK. Upon 4 5 receipt of an application from the person required 6 to conform to the order and by agreement of such person to comply with the order 7 if allowed 8 additional time, the Code Enforcement Officer may 9 grant an extension of time, not to exceed an 10 additional one hundred twenty (120) days, within 11 which to complete said repair, rehabilitation or 12 demolition, if the Code Enforcement Officer 13 determines that such an extension of time will not 14 situation create or perpetuate a imminently 15 dangerous to life or property. The Code 16 Enforcement Officer's authority to extend time is 17 limited to the physical repair, rehabilitation or 18 demolition of the premises and will not in any way 19 affect the time to appeal the notice and directive. 20 SECTION 11: New Section: There is hereby created a new section 21 of the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to

1 be numbered 8.14.100 which shall read as follows: 2 8.14.100. Failure to Repair or Demolish. 3 If the Owner fails to comply with the Code 4 Enforcement Officer's notice and directive pursuant 5 to the requirements set forth herein, or in the 6 event of an appeal, within ten days of the decision 7 of the Building Board of Appeals upholding such 8 notice and directive, the Code Enforcement Officer 9 may direct that the repair or demolition be 10 accomplished by personnel of the City-County or by 11 private contract pursuant to the City-County's 12 contractual procedures set forth in Chapter 3.12 of 13 the Butte-Silver Bow Municipal Code. 14 SECTION 12: There is hereby created a new section of the Butte-

15 Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be numbered
16 8.14.110 which shall read as follows:

17 <u>8.14.110 Notice of Costs and Right to Protest.</u>

18A. Within twenty days after the repair or19demolition of the Dangerous Building is20accomplished by personnel of the City-County or by21private contract, the Owner will be notified of the

costs of such repair or demolition, including administrative costs. If the Owner fails to pay the bill in thirty days, the Code Enforcement officer shall certify the amount of the charges to the Clerk and Recorder for collection.

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6 в. Any person interested in or affected by the 7 proposed charge may file written protests or 8 objections with the Clerk and Recorder and request 9 a hearing before the Council of Commissioners. 10 Each protest objection or must contain а 11 description of the property and grounds of the 12 protest or objection. The Clerk and Recorder shall 13 endorse on every such protest or objection the date 14 of receipt.

C. The Clerk and Recorder shall present the amount of the charges certified by the Code Enforcement Officer and any protests or objections to the Council of Commissioners for consideration, who shall fix a time, date and place for consideration of the certified cost report and any protests or objections thereto.

1 SECTION 13: There is hereby created a new section of the Butte-2 Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be numbered 3 8.14.120 which shall read as follows: 4 8.14.120 Tax Liability for payment of charges. 5 A. If any charges to be paid by the Owner pursuant 6 to Section 8.14.110 have not been paid within thirty 7 (30) days, following notification or in the case of 8 a written objection, within thirty days following 9 the decision of the Council of Commissioners, the 10 Clerk and Recorder shall certify the amount thereof, 11 with the description of the premises charged and 12 shall extend the same to the assessment list as a 13 special tax on the real property. If the real 14 property for any reason is exempt from general 15 taxation, the amount of the charge may be removed by 16 direct claim against the Owner and collected in the 17 same manner as personal taxes. 18 B. The City-County shall notify the responsible

19 party that a lien has been placed on the property by 20 certified mail, return receipt requested.

21 SECTION 13: There is hereby created a new section of the Butte-

Silver Bow Municipal Code (B-SB MC) to be numbered
 8.14.130 which shall read as follows:

3 8.14.130 Repair and Demolition Fund. The Council of 4 Commissioners shall establish a special revolving 5 fund to be designated as the repair and demolition fund. Payments shall be made out of said fund upon 6 the request of a Code Enforcement Officer to defray 7 8 the costs and expenses which may be incurred by the 9 City-County in doing or causing to be done the 10 necessary work or repair or demolition of dangerous 11 buildings.

12 SECTION 14: <u>8.14.140</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this 13 chapter or a section thereof, in any circumstances 14 is held invalid, the validity and application of the 15 remainder of the provisions or sections shall not be 16 affected.

17SECTION 15:8.146.150RemediesNotExclusive.The procedure18established in this chapter are in addition to other19legal remedies established by law which may be20pursued to address violations of this chapter. The21use of this chapter shall be at the sole discretion

of the City-County.

2 SECTION 16: <u>REPEALER.</u> Chapter 15.06 of the Butte-Silver Bow
3 Municipal Code entitled "Code for the Abatement of
4 Dangerous Buildings" is hereby repealed in its
5 entirety.

6 <u>Section 17:</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full
7 force and effect from and after thirty (30) days
8 after its passage and approval.
