

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-721**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CARLTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 6.04.030 RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF SWINE WITHIN THE CITY OF CARLTON**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it necessary and desirable to amend the Carlton Municipal Code Section 6.04.03 to permit the keeping of pot-bellied pigs as pets within the city.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARLTON, OREGON**, as follows:

**Section 1.** Carlton Municipal Code Section 6.04.030 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

**" 6.04.030 - Swine.**

Except for not more than one pot-bellied pig of a weight not to exceed twenty-five pounds being kept solely as a pet, no person shall have or keep swine within the city, except that this section shall not apply to those being transported for commercial purposes. A pig to be kept as a pet must be spayed or neutered by the age of 6 weeks (males) and 14 weeks (females).
