

## **ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 32**

### **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES IN AND FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARPENTERSVILLE SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER TWENTY-ONE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 03-35, the Village of Carpentersville established the Village of Carpentersville Special Service Area No. 21 ("**SSA No. 21**"); and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 03-35 authorizes the Village to levy and extend taxes upon real property within SSA No. 21 on an annual basis, in a total amount not to exceed 0.50% of the value as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue of all taxable property within SSA No. 21; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is necessary, appropriate, and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to levy and extend taxes upon real property within SSA No. 21, as set forth in this Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

#### **SECTION 1: RECITALS.**

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into, and made a part of, this Ordinance as the findings of the Village President and Board of Trustees.

#### **SECTION 2: TAX LEVY.**

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 03-35, the Village of Carpentersville hereby levies \$4,500 in taxes for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, against all taxable property within SSA No. 21, which amount does not exceed 0.50% of the value as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue of all taxable property within SSA No. 21.

#### **SECTION 3: FILING.**

The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Kane County Clerk on or before December 31, 2020.

#### **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance or part thereof is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance will remain in full force and effect, and are to be interpreted, applied, and enforced so as to achieve, as near as may be, the purpose and intent of this Ordinance to the greatest extent permitted by applicable law.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication, in accordance with law.

Motion was made by Trustee Andresen, seconded by Trustee Vela, that the Ordinance be adopted.
