### ORDINANCE 18-57

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20, CHAPTER 20.02.010 OF THE CARPENTERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING VIDEO GAMING FEES FOR NOT-FOR-PROFIT CLASS C LIQUOR LICENSE HOLDERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of authority granted to the municipalities pursuant to the Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/1 *et seq.*, and the Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/1-2 *et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That TITLE 20, CHAPTER 20.02.010 of the Carpentersville Municipal Code shall be amended to include additional language in column 6a, Video gaming terminal fee, in the section titled *Liquor Licenses*, to read as follows, with underlined text being added:

20.02.010 – License, permit and other fees.

The following license and permit fees are established as set forth in the following schedule of fees:

#### **Liquor Licenses**

6a	Video gaming terminal fee	For applications filed through and including December 31, 2018; \$500 per terminal  For applications filed on or after January 1, 2019; \$750 per terminal  <u>For Not-for-profit Class C license holders; \$250 for the first</u>	Section 5.12.265
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		terminal and \$50 for each additional terminal thereafter	
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**SECTION 2:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
