ORDINANCE 19-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, CHAPTER 10.20, SECTION 10.20.010(B) OF THE CARPENTERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its home rule powers, it is necessary and desirable for the Village of Carpentersville to amend its ordinances regarding through streets and stop intersections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carpentersville, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That TITLE 10 – Vehicles and Traffic, CHAPTER 10.20 – Through Streets, Stop Intersections and One-Way Streets, SECTION 10.20.010 – Through Streets and Stop Intersections of the Carpentersville Municipal Code, Paragraph B shall be amended to delete the following streets as designated stop intersections:

1. *Westwood Drive southbound shall stop at the pedestrian crossing immediately south of Westwood Circle*
2. *Westwood Drive (7008) northbound*

The remainder of that Section 10.20.010 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
