BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix C – Capital Improvement Projects, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Public Works, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, by adding a project entitled, "2154 Kaohu Street Building Improvements", in the amount of \$50,000, to read as follows:
