It is ordained by the City Council of the City of Cranston as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2008-57 which amended Title 2, Administration and Personnel, Chapter 2.20.080 of the Code of the City of Cranston, 2005, entitled "Police Pension" "Injured on Duty Disability Pension Entitlement", is hereby repealed and the section deleted in its entirety:

~~{2.20.080—Injured on duty Disability Pension Entitlement~~

~~Police Officer's medically found to be permanently unable to perform the duties of his or her employment as a result of a line of duty illness or injury but having been denied an accidental disability pension by the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island.~~

~~A. In the event that any member of the Cranston Police Department who participates in the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island has been found by the City to have suffered a line of duty illness or injury that has been determined to be a permanently disabling condition, the employee shall be required to apply for an accidental disability pension pursuant to provisions of Rhode Island General Laws §45-21.2-9. In the event that such police officer's application for benefits pursuant to §45-21.2-9 is denied, the City will have the option of requiring the police officer to apply for an ordinary disability pension, so called, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §45-21.2-7.~~

~~B. In the event that such police officer is awarded ordinary disability pension benefits by the State Retirement Board pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §45-21.2-7, the City shall, for the duration of the period in which the police officer remains eligible for such benefits, and in consideration of the occupational disability~~
