

ORDINANCE NO. 1463

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALY CITY  
AMENDING CHAPTER 2.04 OF THE DALY CITY MUNICIPAL CODE RE:  
SALARIES OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS

---

WHEREAS, the salary of the City Council shall be established by ordinance in accordance with provisions of Sections 36516 and 36516.5 of the California Government Code as such provisions now exist or may thereafter be amended.

WHEREAS, the salary of City Council members may be increased by an amount equal to five percent for each calendar year from the operative date of the last adjustment of the salary in effect when the ordinance is enacted; and

WHEREAS, the salaries of the City Council have not increased since 2008, and in conformance with Government Code Section 36516, the City Council desires to increase the city council compensation by 4% for the 14 calendar years from the last salary adjustment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the California Government Code provisions set forth above, the City Council's salary shall be set at \$1,102.92 bi-weekly effective December 13, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALY CITY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to California Government Code Section 36516, Salaries to city councilmembers may be increased by ordinance to an amount equal to five percent for each calendar year; and the prior increase setting the current compensation was hereinbefore made by Daly City Ordinance No. 1327.

**SECTION 2.** Section 2.04.055 of Chapter 2.04 of the Daly City Municipal Code is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

**2.04.055 Councilmember Salaries – Adjustments in Salaries.**

The salary of the Councilmembers shall be a bi-weekly salary of one-thousand one hundred and two dollars and ninety-two cents (\$1,102.92) in accordance with Government Code Section 36516. The salary is payable in the same manner as the salaries are paid to other officers and employees of the city.

**SECTION 3. Environmental Determination.** The City Council of the City of Daly City finds and determines that the implementation of measures described in this Chapter is in furtherance police powers of the City of Daly City, and that these purposes are exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100) of Division 13 of the Public Resources Code, as provided in categorical exemption Classes 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, and or 21 of the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, *California Code of Regulations*, Sections 15301-15329).

**SECTION 4. Severability:** If any section, subsection or sentence of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unlawful, the City Council finds and declares that the remainder of this ordinance would be and is enforceable and would have been adopted notwithstanding the finding of invalidity as to any section, subsection or sentence.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date and Publication:** This Ordinance shall not become effective until after the new term for all local officers begins following the general election of November 8, 2022. This Ordinance shall be published according to law.
