

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALY CITY  
AMENDING SECTIONS 10.36.060, 10.40.120, 10.40.130 AND 10.40.150 OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE RE: PARKING METERS, PERMITS AND FEES

---

The City Council of the City of Daly City, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10.36.060 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.36.060      Depositing coins –Rate.**

The rates adjustments for parking meters shall be set by resolution of the city council.

SECTION 2. Section 10.40 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.40.120      Limit on number of permits to be issued.**

There shall be a limit on the number of permits to be issued to any residential address within the preferential residential permit parking area and such limit shall be set by resolution of the city council. No more than one preferential residential parking permit shall be issued to each motor vehicle for which application is made.

**10.40.130      Display of permits**

Permits shall be affixed upon a motor vehicle in accordance with specifications established by the Daly City Police Department.

**10.40.150      Cost and duration of permits.**

Fees for residential parking permits shall be set by resolution of the city council and permits shall be issued annually.

SECTION 3.    Environmental Determination.

The City Council of the City of Daly City finds and determines that the implementation of measures described in this Chapter is in furtherance police powers of the City of Daly City, and that these purposes are exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100) of Division 13 of the Public Resources Code, as provided in categorical exemption Classes 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, and or 21 of the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, *California Code of Regulations*, Sections 15301-15329).

SECTION 4.    Effective Date and Publication: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage. This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION 5. Severability: If any section, subsection or sentence of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unlawful, the City Council finds and declares that the remainder of this ordinance would be and is enforceable and would have been adopted notwithstanding the finding of invalidity as to any section, subsection or sentence.
